



Balance and debt of general government sector – second EDP notification of 2015



The deficit of the general government sector was HUF 812.2 billion in 2014, 2.5 % of GDP according to the preliminary data of national accounts. According to data compiled in compliance with the methodological requirements of the system of national accounts (ESA2010) the revenues of the sector amounted to HUF 15,243.1 billion and its expenditures to HUF 16,055.3 billion. Revenues and expenditures were both up by 7.8% compared to 2013.

Based on data of the National Bank of Hungary, general government debt amounted to HUF 24,514 billion, 76.2% of GDP at the end of 2014. Deficit and debt data are the same as those issued in the [first release](#) published on 1 October 2015.

HCSO reported the data to Eurostat, the Statistical Office of the EU in compliance with the regulation on the Excessive Deficit Procedure (EDP), according to the methodological requirements of the European System of Accounts (ESA2010).

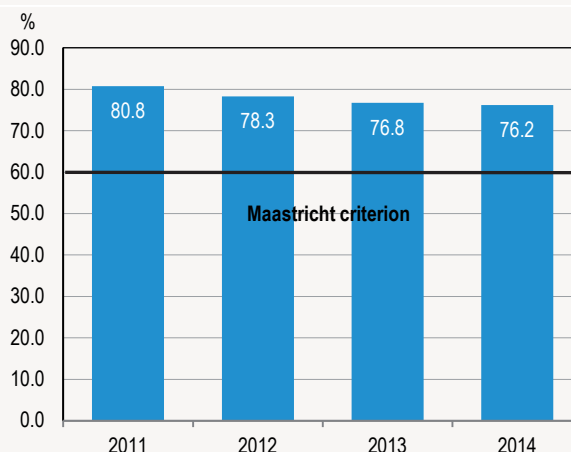
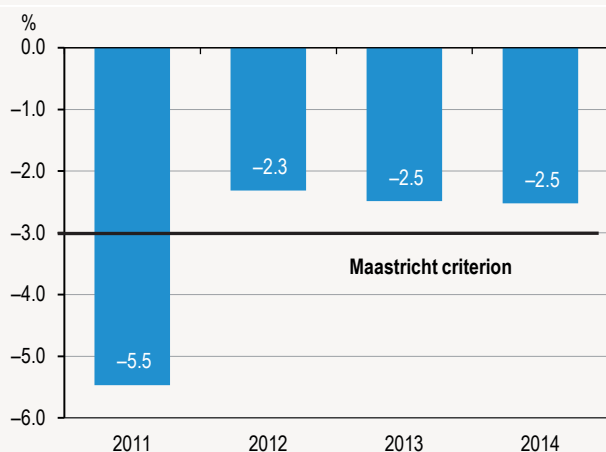
